#### Rideability – Increasing Independence

+ colts = RIDEABILITY

Lona Workman shared on Facebook page her story about a daily life activity that most of us take for granted.

"Yesterday I had long pretty fingernails last night I chewed them off and my stomach feels like it is just shaking. I have been having a hard time adjusting to the fact that I can't drive anymore and so I have to depend on someone else to take me anywhere, and I have to go where they want to go to shop or wherever they want to go.

"This morning I realized what I'm going through, is the fact that I can't make plans anymore. I can't say, tomorrow I'm going to do this or that, because unless someone wants to take me I can't do anything. And it's frustrating.

"I'm 82 years old and have been doing whatever I wanted to do, or go wherever I want to go for most of my life. And I'm not trying to blame anyone; it's just the way it is. And there is nothing I can do about it. I just realized why I'm so depressed these days." The Stevens Center understands the feeling of Ms. Workman. Since 2014, the Stevens Center has operated Rideability, funded in part by a grant from NC Department of Transportation to provide limited evening and weekend transportation for individuals with a documented disabling condition. The cause of the disability does not matter. Passengers pay \$1 per oneway trip.

Signing up is easy. A one page form must be completed with the proof of disability provided (such as a doctor's note, living in a licensed setting such as a group home, attending a program for people with disabilities, receiving or receiving disability income). The Stevens Center will provide a photo ID, and then rides can be scheduled.

For more information, call 919-776-4048 and talk with Gail Brown. She will make arrangements to help complete the process and is available to speak before groups and do group signups for agencies.
